The *Mission* should be practical in feasibility and scope, and focuses upon 5 or 6 key themes that define who we are as a parish community at Saint Elizabeth.

Goal One: Become a more Engaging Parish

To be a faith filled and inviting Catholic community that welcomes and engages all people wherever they are in their spiritual journey.

This goal calls parish staff and parishioners to engage others in order to involve them in a more active participation in the life of the parish community. This engagement is grounded upon the conviction that belonging leads to believing. It follows the example of Jesus, who did not wait around for people to find him, but rather reached out to others, welcoming them with an open heart and inviting them to share in his mission and ministry.

Goal Two: Expand Family Faith Formation Programs

To develop opportunities at all stages of family life that enrich relationships and bring Christ into our homes.

This goal focuses upon helping families to grow in the transforming love of God by understanding the Catholic Faith more fully and by living it out more consistently. It is founded upon the conviction that nurturing a vibrant faith life in families (parents, children and their extended families) will enable them to apply their beliefs and moral values to the daily challenges of family life.

Goal Three: Strengthen Youth and Young Adult Faith Formation Programs

To offer relevant programs to nourish in youth and young adults a deeper personal relationship with Christ, their Catholic faith and the parish community.

This goal commits the parish community to an effective engagement of its youth and young adults, helping them to develop a personal relationship with Jesus Christ that enables them to respond to their Baptismal vocation to follow in Jesus' footsteps and make a difference in the world. It is founded upon the conviction that all of us are called to holiness, a prayerful relationship with Jesus that shapes our faith in Him and our living as His disciples.

Goal Four: Continue to Grow our Stewardship Identity

To increase participation and strengthen our commitment to live a stewardship way of life by sharing God's gifts of time, talent, and treasure.

This goal reaffirms Catholic Stewardship as integral to our personal identity as disciples and to our shared identity as a community of disciples. Each of us and all of us together are called to receive God's gifts gratefully, cultivate them responsibly, share them lovingly with others and return them with increase to the Lord. The spiritual perspective of Stewardship shapes all that we do as followers of Jesus Christ.

Goal Five: Enhance Parish Wide Communications

To expand the use of communication and marketing programs and tools to support parish goals and to reach parishioners, promote parish activities and grow a more informed and connected parish.

This goal commits parish staff and stewardship volunteers to design and implement effective vehicles of communication that ensure that all parishioners are well-informed about and regularly invited to participate in the life and ministry of the parish community. In the words of Pope Francis on World Communications Day 2016: "Communication wherever and however it takes place, has opened up broader horizons for many people. This is a gift of God which involves a great responsibility."

Goal Six: Encourage Leadership Development

To encourage leadership and develop relevant skills within our parish community, parish school and staff to live out our parish mission.

This goal calls parish staff to identify, enlist and prepare parishioners to take greater responsibility the life and ministry of the parish community. It is founded upon the conviction that connecting with others is at the heart of leadership, that effective leadership is defined by one's actions with others, and that leadership development is a never-ending task to ensure the future well-being of the parish community.
